Your Directors have pleasure in presenting the Third Annual Report together with the Audited Accounts of the Company for the year ended March 31, 2010

PROJECT OF THE COMPANY

Your Company was incorporated as a Joint Venture between Jaiprakash Associates Limited (JAL) and Gujarat Mineral Development Corporation Limited (GMDC), *inter-alia*, to implement a 2.4 Million tones per annum capacity cement plant in District Kutch, Gujarat.

Approximately 484 hectares of land is required for setting up the cement plant. Pending approval and issue of the new Jantri for fixing the rates for valuation of Government land by the Government of Gujarat, the Government land is yet to be acquired by the Company.

Environment impact assessment on the identified land has, in the meanwhile, been made and clearance from State Wild Life Protection & Forest Dept has also been received for the proposed cement plant. Environmental Clearance is expected to be received as soon as the identified Government land is transferred in Company's name. Technical consultants are also working on the engineering of the Project.

DIVIDEND

Since the Company's project is still under implementation, no dividend is recommended.

SHARE CAPITAL

The Authorized Share Capital of the Company is Rs. 100 crore and the paid-up capital of the Company on March 31, 2010 stood at Rs. 73,40,000/-.

DIRECTORATE

Since the last report of Directors dated May 7, 2009, Shri V.S.Gadhavi, IAS has been appointed as Director w.c.f. December 21, 2009 in place of Smt. V.L. Joshi.

The Board placed on record its deep appreciation for the valuable contribution made by Smt. V.L. Joshi during her tenure as Director of the Company.

Shri Manoj Gaur, Shri P.V. Vora and Shri Vipul H. Raja, Directors of the Company shall retire by rotation at the forthcoming Annual General Meeting and, being eligible, offer themselves for re-appointment.

AUDITORS

M/s DPSV & Associates, Chartered Accountants (Registration No. 325669E), Statutory Auditors of the Company will retire at the conclusion of the Third Annual General Meeting and are eligible for reappointment. They have, pursuant to Section 224(1B) of the Companies Act, 1956, furnished a Certificate regarding their eligibility for reappointment as Statutory Auditors of the Company.

FIXED DEPOSITS

The Company has not accepted any deposit within the meaning of Section 58A of the Companies Act, 1956 and the Rules made thereunder.

PARTICULARS OF EMPLOYEES

During the period under report none of the employees was in receipt of remuneration prescribed under Section 217(2A) of the Companies Act. 1956, read with the Companies (Particulars of Employees) Rules, 1975.

SCHEDULE - G

SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES AND NOTES ON ACCOUNTS

A. SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

1. GENERAL

- i) The accounts are prepared on the historical cost basis and on the principles of going concern.
- Accounting policies not specifically referred to otherwise are consistent and in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles.

2. FIXED ASSETS

Fixed Assets are stated at cost. Cost of Fixed Assets is arrived at after including therein expenses for bringing the respective assets to working conditions.

3. DEPRECIATION

Depreciation on Fixed Assets has been provided on Straight Line Method at the rates prescribed under Schedule XIV of the Companies Act, 1956 as amended. Depreciation has been provided on pro-rata basis with reference to the date of addition / installation.

4. RECOGNITION OF INCOME AND EXPENDITURE

Revenue/Incomes & Cost/Expenditures are accounted for on accrual basis as they are earned or incurred.

5. INCIDENTAL EXPENDITURE DURING CONSTRUCTION PERIOD

Expenditure incurred on the project during implementation will be capitalized and apportioned to various assets on commissioning of the project.

6. PRELIMINARY EXPENSES

Preliminary Expenses will be amortised after commencement of commercial operation.

7. TAXATION

Provision for current Income Tax is made in accordance with the Income Tax Act, 1961.

8. Foreign Currency Transaction

Transactions in Foreign Currency are recorded at the Rate of Exchange prevailing on the date of Transaction. Exchange difference attributable to the acquisition of Fixed Assets are accounted for in Pre-operative Expenses Pending Allocation.

9. Retirement Benefits:

- i) Liability on account of Leave encashment and gratuity at year end is being provided on accrual basis.
- ii) Contributions to Provident Fund is made at prescribed rates to the Provident Fund Commissioner and absorbed in the Profit and Loss account.

10. Provisions:

A provision is recognized when an enterprise has a present obligation as a result of past event; it is probable that an outflow of resources will be required to settle the obligation, in respect of which a reliable estimate can be made. Provisions are not discounted to present value and are determined based on best estimate required to settle the obligation at the balance sheet date. These are reviewed at each balance sheet date and are adjusted to reflect the current best estimates

11. CONTINGENT LIABILITY

Contingent Liability is not provided for in the books of accounts and are disclosed by way of Notes on Accounts.

B. NOTES ON ACCOUNTS

- Capital Commitment outstanding as on March 31, 2010 (Net of Advance) is Rs NIL (March 31, 2009: Rs 2,02,40,000/-)
- Contingent liabilities Rs. NIL as on 31st March, 2010.
- No Profit & Loss Account for the period ended 31st March, 2010 has been prepared since the company has not yet commenced its commercial operation.
- The Company is a joint venture company in pursuance of a Shareholders' Agreement entered into between M/s. Jaiprakash Associates Limited and M/s. Gujarat Mineral Development Corporation Limited on 1st June, 2007.
- Incidental Expenditure during Construction Period for the year is net of Rs. 90,67,073/- in respect of Interest earned by the company on FDR with Bank. (Previous year Rs. 47,21,396/-)
- Expenses incurred for registration/ formation of the Company amounting to Rs.57,04,378/has been treated as 'Preliminary Expenses' and will be amortised after commencement of commercial operation.
- The Company has only one employee during the year. The Company contributes 12% of the salary towards provident fund managed by Employees Provident Fund Organisation of India. Provision for leave encashment and gratuity has been provided for on accrual basis. Other short-term benefits of the employee like medical expenses and LTC has been accounted for as per company's rules and charged to expenses during construction period account.
- There is no Deferred Tax Liabilities / Assets as at 31st March, 2010.
- There are no Small Scale Industrial Undertakings to whom the company owes more than Rs.1,00,000/- outstanding for more than 30 days as at 31st March, 2010.
- 10 Expenses incurred for conducting the various surveys, mining development, and other expenses related to the 2.4 million ton cement project has been transferred to Capital Work-In-Progress including preoperative expenses pending allocation. The details of expenses transferred to Capital Work-In-Progress account including incidental expenses during construction period has been given below:
